Were targets to exact IPSC specification? All the targets were according to the IPSC Competition Rules.

General comment about course design. The course design was approved as is by IPSC and didn't present any construction problems.

Stage construction. Construction was sturdy and lasted the whole match. The round plates were bolted to the pedestals and the bolts started breaking off after a couple of squads. Repairs were quick and didn't slow the match. All moving targets worked as intended.

Any comment about the written stage briefings.


No. Only one change was made during the vetting.
