



South African Institute of Range Officers and Instructors Level III and higher match Call-up

Pre-amble

As SAPSA membership grows, the number of slots available to participate in the main match is diminishing; as S.A.I.R.O & I membership grows, the number of applications accepted is going to exceed the number of match officials for that match.

Currently, the call-up is done simultaneous to the entry form for the match being distributed to all members. This means that if a S.A.I.R.O & I member is not selected as a match official for that match, the S.A.I.R.O & I member will have to then go on a waiting-list for the main match. Alternatively, the SAIRO & I member may apply for a slot in the main match simultaneous to applying to officiate at the match, and pay the entry fee (which is refunded if the S.A.I.R.O & I member is accepted as a match official). Neither scenario is ideal.

Procedure

S.A.I.R.O & I will circulate the call-up for the match to all provincial associations and Board members / provincial representatives, immediately following the completion of a Level III match in that discipline, or not later than 3 months before the match (whichever is applicable).

S.A.I.R.O & I members will have two (2) weeks to apply for the match, following which S.A.I.R.O & I will notify the applicants (via email) of the match officials for that match, no later than one (1) week after the close of applications.

Once the applicants have been notified of the match officials for that match, SAPSA will distribute the entry form to all SAPSA members. It is then the responsibility of those applicants who were not selected, to apply for a slot in the main match timeously, should they wish to participate.

Successful applicants wishing to participate in the pre-match must complete the entry form (with provincial signature) and return to the SAPSA office within two (2) weeks of notification else they will not be entered in the match.

Stipulations

- No names will be added to the list of applicants without a fully completed Application form being received.
- Once applications close, S.A.I.R.O & I will liaise with the nominated Range Master for that match, on the selection of the match officials.
- No names will be entered for the match without a completed and signed entry form being submitted to the SAPSA office, if applicable.
